**RESOLUTION ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026
FUNDED BY SB1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017**

1 WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017
2 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by
3 the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation
4 funding shortfalls statewide; and

5
6 WHEREAS, SB1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure
7 the residents of the County are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our
8 community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

9
10 WHEREAS, Pursuant to SHC Section 2034(a)(1) project list shall not limit the flexibility
11 of an eligible county to fund projects in accordance with local needs and priorities, so
12 long as the projects are consistent with SHC Section 2030(b). After submittal of the
13 project list to the Commission, in the event a county elects to make changes to the
14 project list pursuant to the stature provisions noted above, formal notification of the
15 Commission is not required; and

16
17 WHEREAS, the County must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive
18 fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA),
19 created by SB1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed
20 project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life
21 of the improvement; and

23 WHEREAS, the County will receive an estimated \$3,757,495 in RMRA funding in
24 Fiscal Year 2025-2026 from SB1; and

26 WHEREAS, this is the 9th year in which the County is receiving SB1 funding and will
27 enable the County to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects,
28 safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access
29 and mobility options for the traveling public that would not otherwise been possible
30 without SB1 funds; and

1 WHEREAS, the County has undergone a public process to ensure public input into our
2 community's transportation priorities/the project list, including public meetings to
3 review various plans developed through the Lake Area Planning Council and Board of
4 Supervisors meetings to review the 10-Year Pavement Rehabilitation Plan; and

6 WHEREAS, the County selected projects from the 10-Year Pavement Rehabilitation
7 Plan to develop the Department of Public Works Short-Term Work Plan described in
8 Board Memorandum/Legislative Text associated with this Resolution; and

9
10 WHEREAS, the County listed bridge projects from the Lake County – Department of
11 Public Works, Bridge Maintenance/Replacement Prioritization Plan dated May 28,
12 2009; and

13
14 WHEREAS, the County developed the SB1 project list to ensure revenues are being
15 used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the
16 community's priorities for transportation investment; and

17
18 WHEREAS, the funding from SB1 will help the County rehabilitate approximately 21
19 miles of road and repair or replace at least 3 bridges throughout the County; and

20
21 WHEREAS, the infrastructure investments in the projects identified in the SB1 project
22 list will have a significant positive benefit for residents and businesses throughout the
23 County; and

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors, County of Lake,
26 State of California, that:

28 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.

30 2. The following list of newly proposed projects shown in Exhibit A will be funded
31 solely or in-part with Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Road Maintenance and
32 Rehabilitation Account revenues.
